# Achievements since Rotterdam, May 2007 (1)

- Actions in Implementation Plan from Rotterdam completed, monitored by the Core Group
- 6-monthly report by Rapporteur to CEN/BT and to the Construction Sector Network, on Website
- 100 more hEN published, with supporting standards



# Achievements since Rotterdam, May 2007 (2)

- Remaining EN Eurocode Parts published, total 58
- Snapshot of detailed progress updated regularly on Website
- T 350 *Sustainability of construction works* and TC 351 *Construction products-Assessment of release of dangerous substances* fully active
