Introduction - context

- BWR 3 title is **Health, hygiene and the environment**. It is one out of 7 BWR in 206
- Work under the **LMI sustainable construction**
Whole life cycle to be considered
- BWR3 mission is to identify missing standards in its field
- Breakout-session to brain-storm on domains included in or excluded from BWR3 field.

CSN Conf. 2009 – BT/WG 206 – BWR 3

Main findings 1/2

- Included : emission of Regulated Dangerous Substances from construction products into indoor air and water-soil in the in use phase and for intended uses (TC 351 standards)
- Included : installation (may address in situ “fabrication” activities)
- Included : maintenance

CSN Conf. 2009 – BT/WG 206 – BWR 3

Main findings 2/2

- Excluded : Sustainable use of natural resources (BWR 7)
- Excluded : Production (BWR 7)
- End of life (BWR 7)
- Included-excluded ??? Design aspects (example TC 156 on ventilation)
- Included-excluded ??? Management aspects (example procurement ???)

- Are **management** aspects part of BT/WG 206 field of assessment ?
